The Nancy Sever Gallery is pleased to present an exhibition of recent work by Cameron Haas, whose outstanding talent as an abstract artist is recognised internationally.

Cameron Haas was born in Hobart in 1981. He began studying fine art at the University of Tasmania and completed his studies at the National Art School in Sydney where he graduated with a Bachelor of Fine Arts with Honours in 2010. He has been exhibiting since 2009 and this is his fifth exhibition at the Nancy Sever Gallery.

Although these are seemingly simple compositions, every colour, tone, shape, intersection and edge has been carefully considered and composed. There is nowhere for the artist to hide. The viewer has an opportunity to play with these organic, malleable shapes that are suggestive of an embodied human experience but which are not prescriptive.

'Each painting starts with pencil on paper as a line drawing', the artist writes, 'and the initial composition must have an uncomplicated authority in how it sits on the stark, white paper. This basic but fundamental beginning is an essential foundation on which I make paintings. Colour is added and adjusted as the drawing becomes more fully realised into what will be the final work. This allows me to interact with the individual paintings sensitively, as a whole work. It is my intention that these paintings will have a unique resonance with each viewer'.

The exhibition is on show from 2 August until 10 September 2023.

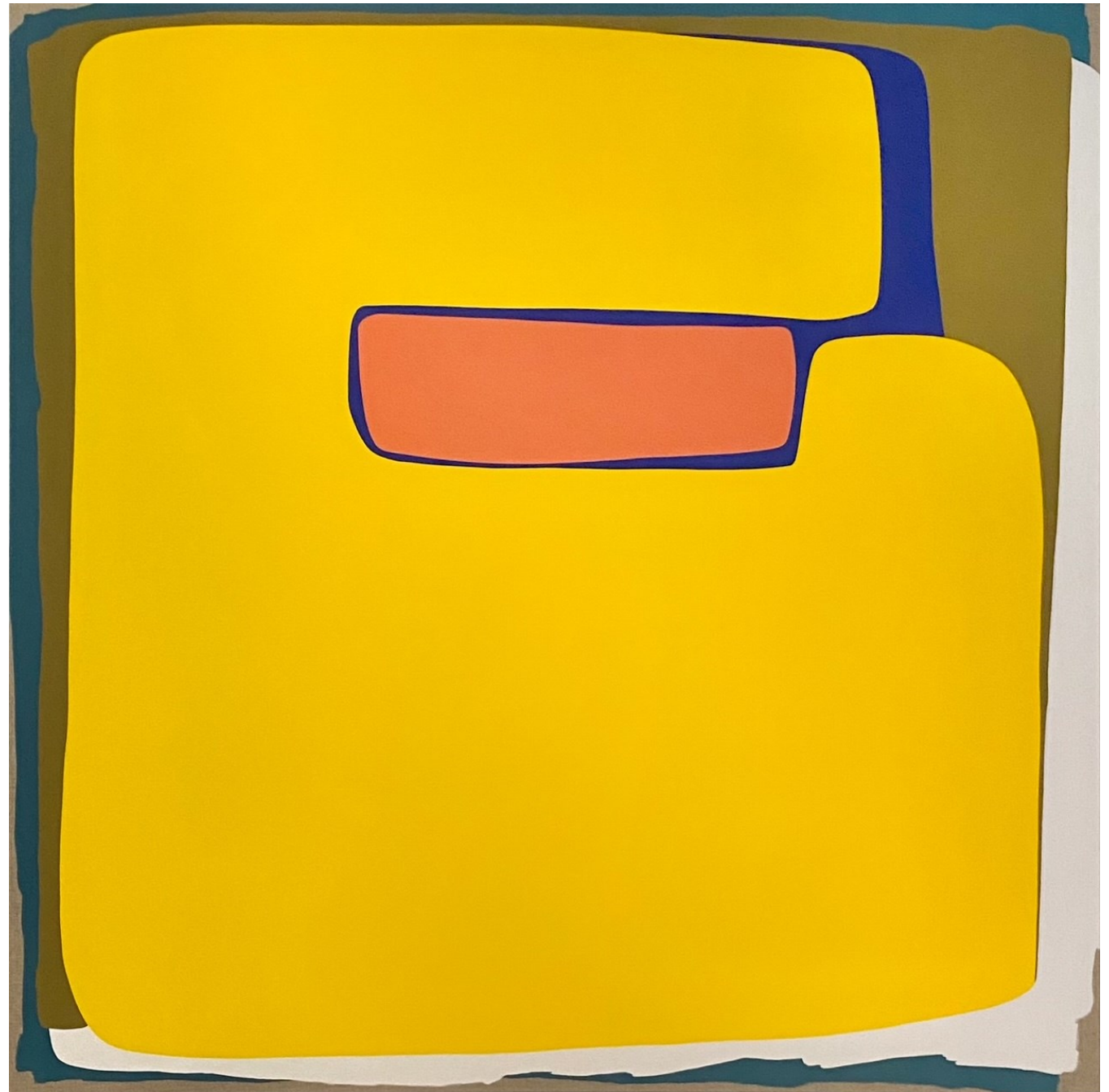
