The Nancy Sever Gallery is pleased to present *Daam Booroo - Reflections on Country*, an exhibition of recent works by four artists from the Warmun Arts Centre: Mabel Juli, Gordon Barney, Tommy Carroll and Madeline Purdie.

Mabel Juli is one of Australia's most revered indigenous painters. Her work is to be found in the National Gallery of Australia and all State art galleries, along with that of Gordon Barney and Tommy Carroll. Madeline Purdie is an exceptionally talented emerging artist.

All four are Gija artists from the remote East Kimberley region of Western Australia. Their lives have been driven by the need to put cross-cultural communication and education into practice through art. What connects them is an encyclopaedic knowledge of Gija Country, their skills as expert cross-cultural communicators and educators, and their desire to share their art within their own community and to audiences beyond. Their paintings explore the vast areas of the spectacular Gija Country.

The paintings in this exhibition are simultaneously geographical, historical and biographical. Country is mapped with ochre in a rich tapestry of narratives that illustrate the present and the past, the artists' personal lives and those of their ancestors.

These artists use painting to depict places that are hard to access, practices discontinued, knowledge shared and fond memories, so that they may endure. The landscape becomes the forum for discourse derived from and located in memory.

Natural forms and geographic locations articulate cultural histories. Features in the landscape such as hills, trees, rocks, waterholes and rivers appear as motifs but they represent the history of the land.

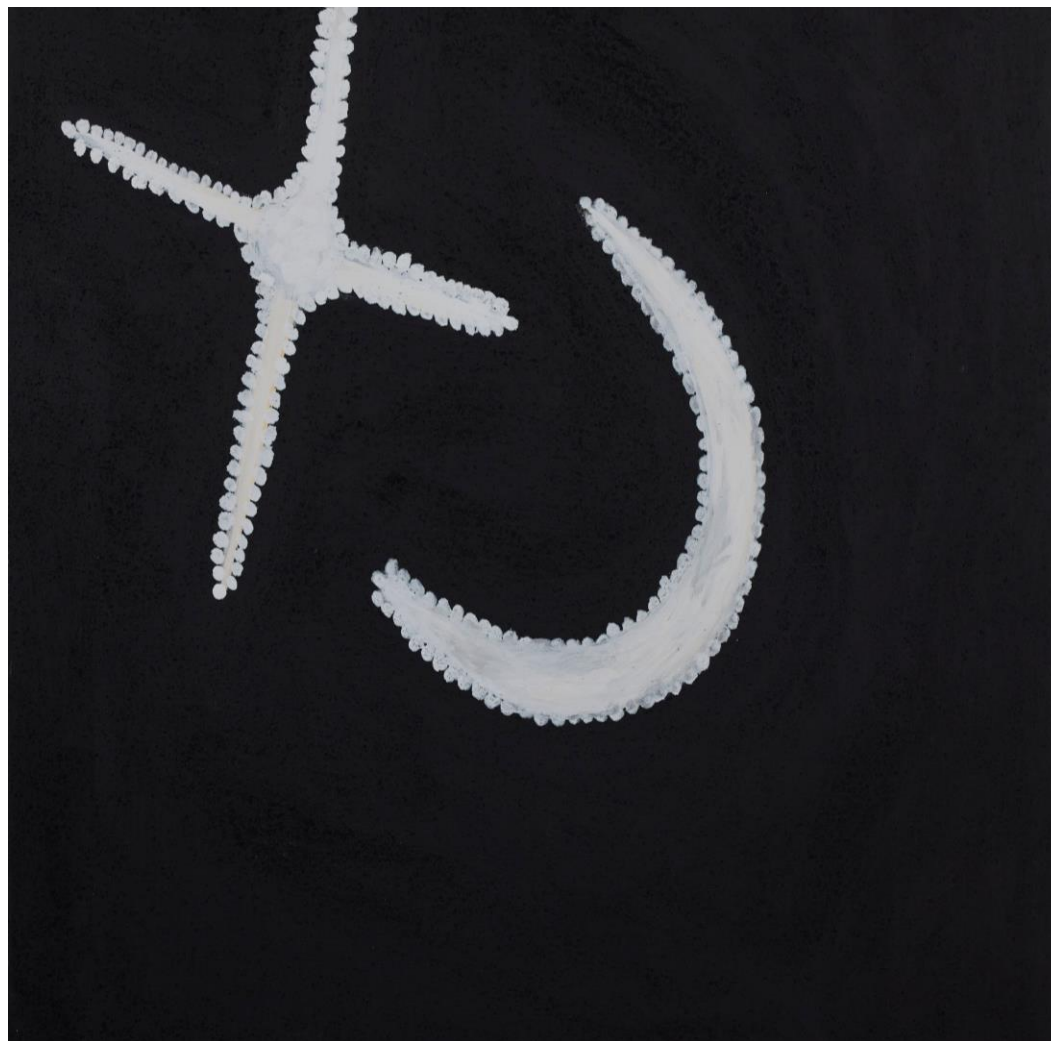

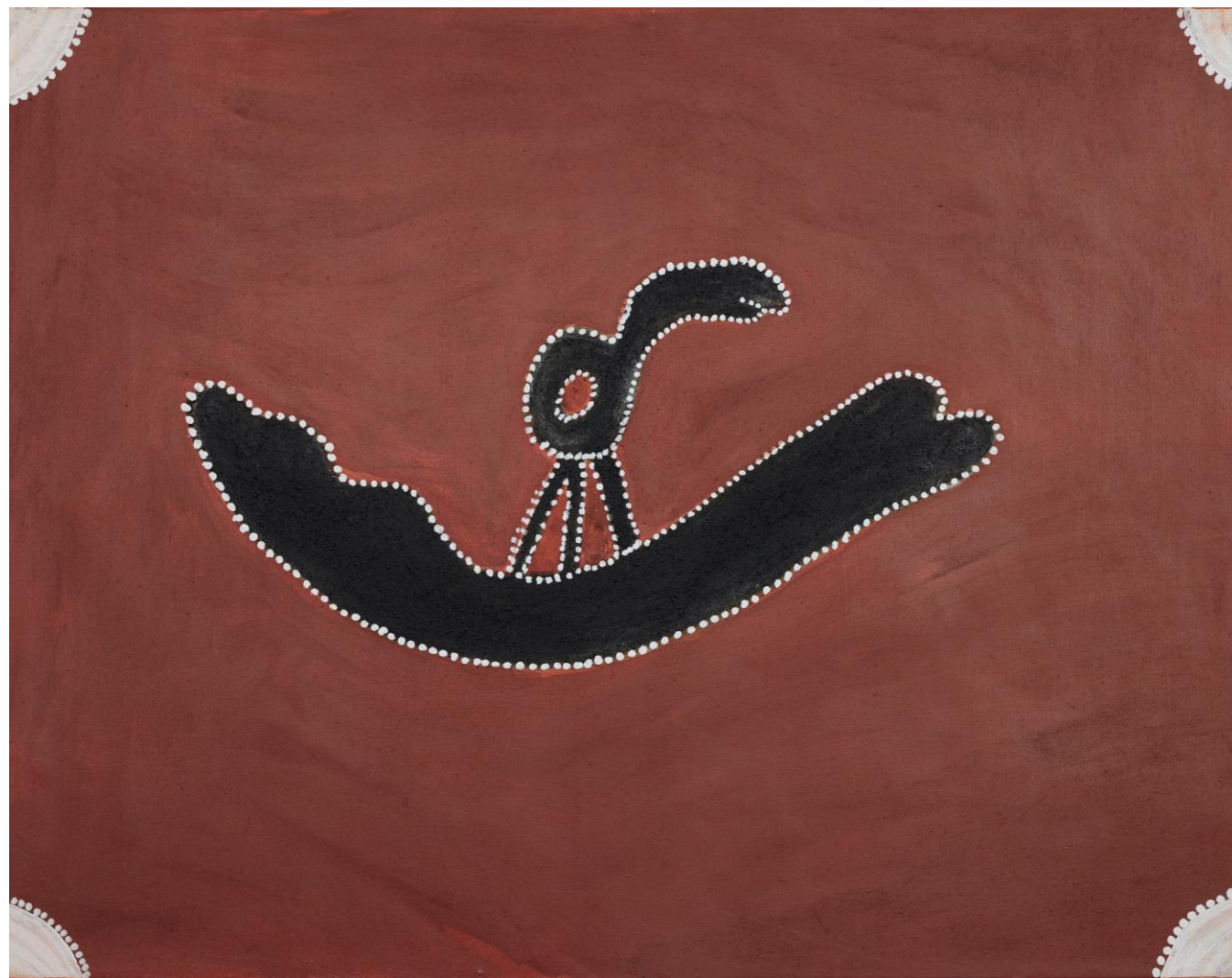

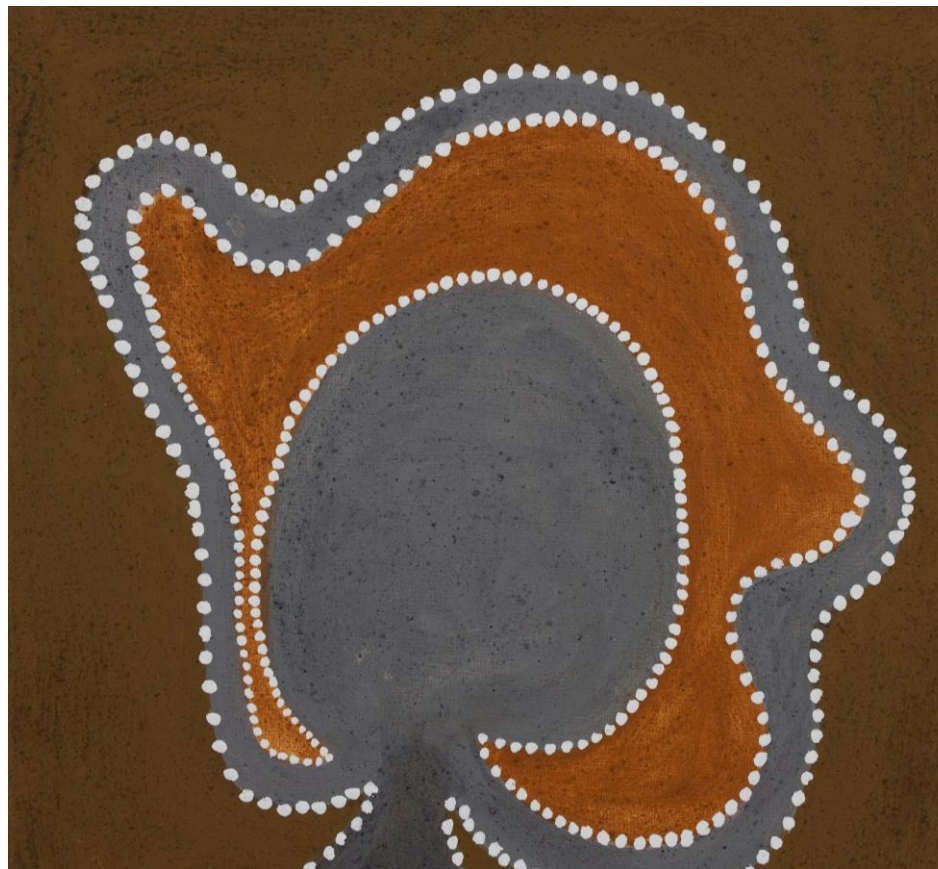

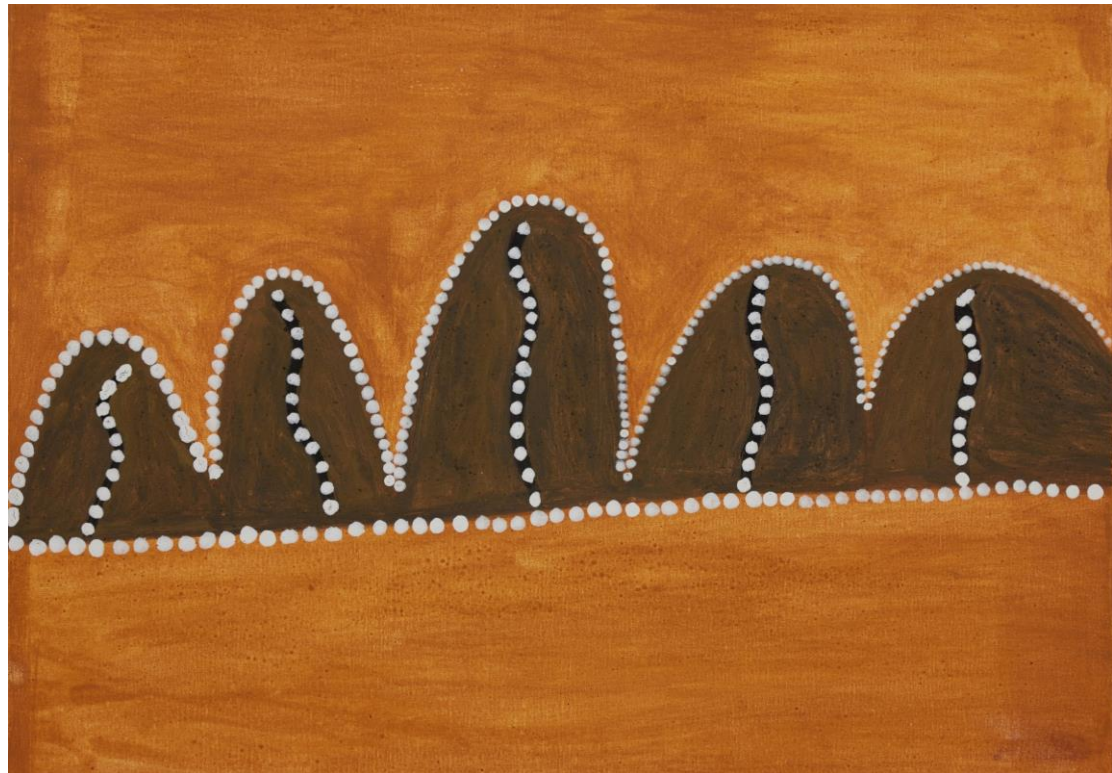

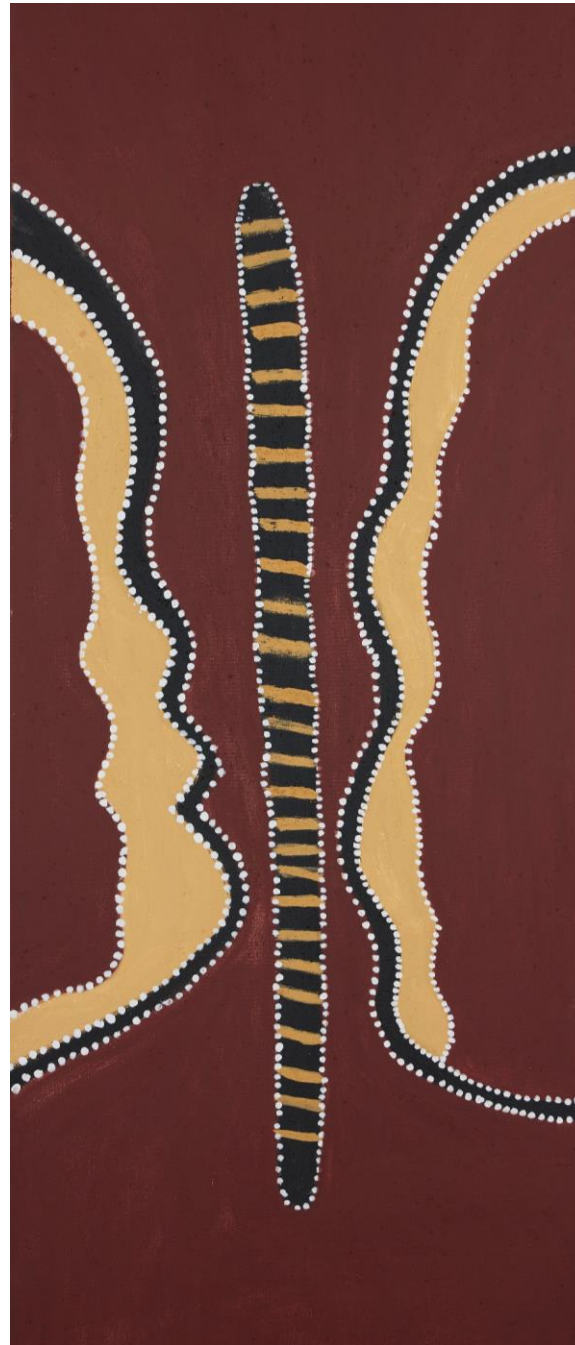

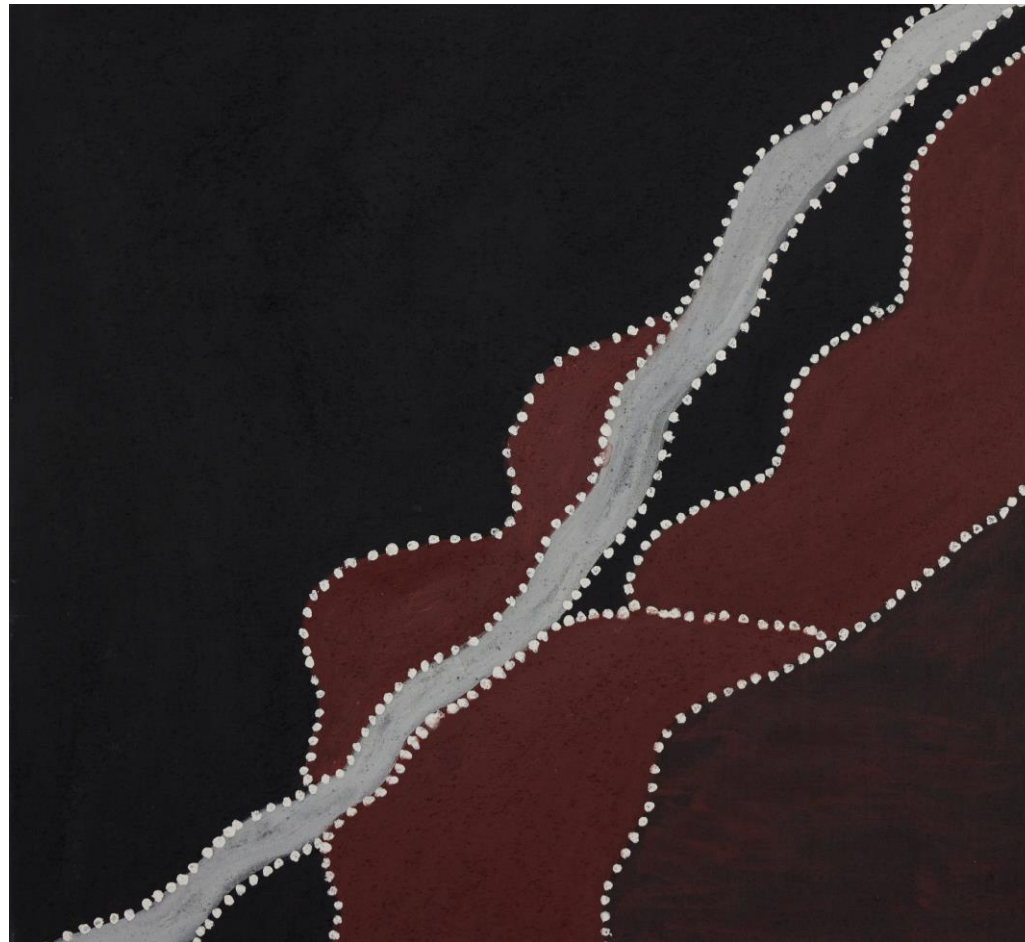
